


WP Photo Seller – How to add an attachment to a photo for delivery

This feature lets you attach any file with a photo that gets delivered when someone purchase the item. This is useful if you wanted to deliver additional files (example: a Photoshop file, an Adobe Illustrator file) with a particular photo.

Go to **WP Photo Seller -> Gallery -> Existing Galleries** and open a gallery you wish to edit. Scroll down to **Gallery Images section**, select an image you wish to add an attachment to and click on **edit**.


In the image edit screen, you will see a section named **Image Attachment Settings**.

Image Attachment Settings



The 'Image Attachment Settings' form contains the following fields and buttons:

- Image Variation: Choose a variation for which you want to send an attachment file to your customers when they buy this image.
- Attachment File: Choose the attachment file which you want to send your customers when they purchase the above variations. (You can upload more attachment files by using the "Upload Files" button below.)


Use the "Upload Files" button to upload attachment files (you can upload as many files as you want). All your uploaded files will become available in the "Attachment File" dropdown menu. This allows you to attach different files to different variations of the photo/image.

Image Variation



Attachment File


Select the file from the drop down menu and click on **Save Attachment** button.
